Everyone must furnish his/her own SCBA. SCBA bottles will be refilled by Tarrant County College Staff only. No beards or long sideburns are allowed.

Everyone attending the Swift Water Class is required to bring a swimsuit, comfortable tennis shoes and a towel. Wetsuits are preferred.

There will be a limit of five members per department for the Swift Water Awareness class only.
