- 2. This item has been recommended by Fire and approved by Public Works Fleet Services.
- 3. **Impact**: Replacement of aging front-line equipment through the purchase of new equipment that maintains the uniformity of the fire fleet will ensure familiarity with the equipment for firefighters and shop personnel as well as allowing the fire department to retire reserve apparatus that are costly to maintain, thus ensuring that emergency services are provided in the most efficient means possible without interruptions.
- 4. The three fire engine/pumpers will replace engines with City Tags #05108, #05102, and #05088. Once purchased, engines with City Tag #05108 and #05102 will be moved into reserve status and two of the current reserve fire engines will be retired. The engine with City Tag #05088 will be moved into Public Education. The aerial ladder truck will replace City Tag #05076, which will be moved into reserve status and one current reserve aerial ladder truck will be retired. The air/light utility vehicle will replace City Tag #05062 which will also be moved into reserve status.
